we do?

Juvenile Justice System

- Delinquency
 - Conduct educational reviews at the request of the court
 - Confer with students and parents/guardians
 - Consult with schools
 - Provide feedback to schools & the court
 - Assist students with selecting and enrolling in school programs
 - Testify on school districts behalf

Juvenile Justice System

- Dependency
 - Facilitate in and out-of area transfers for students under DCF supervision
 - Convey information to and from the courts to appropriate school staff
 - Confer with guardians, GAL, and DCF
 - Conduct educational assessments
 - Follow-up on cases

The Students we Serve

- The most at risk population within Miami-Dade County Public Schools
 - ESE students
 - Students with open Delinquency and Dependency cases
 - Students in transition and high mobility
 - Students in crisis
 - Students with no stability
 - Students with poor school attendance
