Providing Documentation

To be eligible for accommodations on College Board exams, a student must have documentation showing evidence of the following:

- The disability
- The degree to which the student's activities are affected (functional limitation)
- The need for the specific accommodations requested.

Seven Documentation Criteria:

Acceptable documentation meets seven broad criteria:

- The diagnosis is clearly stated.
- Information is current.
- Educational, developmental, and medical history is presented.
- The diagnosis is supported.
- The functional limitation is described.
- Recommended accommodations are justified.

Evaluators' professional credentials are established.

Time Frame of Application for Accommodations

It takes about seven weeks for approval of accommodations for any given test.
